The new Journal of Systems Integration continues the tradition of *Systemova integrace* as an on-line journal.

We seek original contributions on the following topics:

Instruction for authors

The paper must be an original unpublished work written in good English.

The paper must be written in MS Word text editor version 2003 or higher.

The paper should not exceed 20 typeset pages (1,800 characters per page, including spaces) in length.

The author is responsible for scientific accuracy, originality, and the formal appropriateness of the article. If the submitted article has been published in another journal, it cannot be accepted. The editorial board has the right to refuse publication of the article. We recommend that the author(s) define the thematic field in which the article fits, but the board of editors makes the final decision regarding its positioning.

Each paper is briefly assessed by one of the Journal editors, who checks whether the paper satisfies the journal requirements. If it does, they send the manuscript to two referees. On receiving both referee reports, the editor decides either to accept or reject the paper (in the case of similar referee recommendations) or to request a third report (if the two referees disagree). The editor may also send the manuscript back to the authors for substantive revision and re-submission without consulting the referees.

Papers are not rewarded.
